Thursday evening – entries are due (no pre-entry required) 6:30 pm – 8:00 pm

Friday – judging of exhibits 8:00 am – 10:00 am (closed to public during this time)

Open to the public from Noon – 8:00 pm

Saturday - Open to the public from 12:30 am until 3:30 pm.

All entries need to be picked up between 3:30-4:00 pm. Any items not picked up will be disposed of if perishable.

Rules:

Limit 5 entries per person, per division. Open to all age groups unless otherwise stated. Items should not have been shown at a previous fair. Only items made since previous CSD should be entered. No premiums will be awarded. Each project will receive a ribbon. Items marked "for sale" will be handled by the exhibitor and purchaser. CSD committee will not handle the sale of any items.

Divisions:

Art – oil painting, charcoal, pencil, water-color, or Crayola.

Canned goods – labeled and dated.

Craft I – recycle, reduce, reuse (any item made from a recycled item).

Craft II – any item hand made.

Craft III – items made under supervised direction. High School only.

Baked Goods – cookies, cakes, or breads (recipe and instructions should be included)

Flowers – potted, fresh cut, non-live arrangements. Categories—seasonal, creative.

Needle Work – Any project such as needle point, embroidery, or cross-stitch.

Photography – scenery, people, or animals.

Sewing – Any item that is hand-made using a needle and thread.

Quilts – hand quilted or machine quilted. Categories – baby, holiday, animal, and patriotic.

Rock Painting - hand-painted or hand-crafted for hunting. Should include "Sarcoxie" on it.

Vegetables – should be home grown and not purchased.

Wood Working – any item made by hand.

3D Printing – Any item created in 3D from a printer.
