General Rules and Regulations

1. Any member of an organized youth group in **Jasper, Newton, Barton, or Lawrence** counties, or if you previously exhibited livestock at the Chief Sarcoxie Days Livestock show may exhibit.
2. Proper exhibitor conduct is necessary for the continued success of our show. Failure to conduct yourselves as ladies and/or gentlemen could result in expulsion from the show.
3. Pre-entry of all livestock is required (see entry form at the end of the fair book)
ALL entries including peewee must be pre entered by September 1, 2021.
4. All animals must be in place by **10:00 p.m. on Friday**. Animals may be brought in Thursday night, but it will be the responsibility of the exhibitor. No supervision will be on the grounds Thursday night.
5. Release time for livestock is **6:00 p.m. on Saturday**. No entry may leave prior to release time unless special permission is received from show superintendent. No trailers moved until superintendent gives permission.
6. Any exhibitor that has their livestock penned in the concrete area is responsible for cleaning those pens and placing the bedding in the center cattle aisle of the barn to facilitate cleanup **NO EXCEPTIONS !!!**
7. The Chief Sarcoxie Days Fair Board would like to **discourage** the use of straw bale dividers between animals due to limited space.
8. The Chief Sarcoxie Days Fair Board reserves the right to limit the number of entries per exhibitor.
9. **No parking of vehicles or trailers in the street on the north or east side of the fair barn during the show on Saturday. THERE IS NO PARKING LOT EAST OF THE ARENA ANYMORE. YOU MUST FIND PARKING OF TRAILERS, ETC. ELSEWHERE.**
10. **Premiums will be forfeited if exhibitor leaves early without superintendent approval.**

REMINDER OF RULES

1. **NO LATE** entries accepted
2. Tie outs **MUST** be assigned by superintendent
3. CAN **NOT** go to tie outs until 10:00 p.m.
4. Tie outs **MUST** be cleaned to superintendent's satisfaction or premiums **WILL** be held
5. All Isles **MUST** stay clean and open
6. Exhibitor must be 8 years old in order to show in competitive classes
7. For species that are in Round robin; In order to be eligible for showmanship, **MUST** be present for Round Robin Showmanship following sheep show
8. Release time, no trailers moved until superintendent gives permission.
9. **THERE IS NO PARKING LOT EAST OF THE ARENA ANYMORE. YOU MUST FIND PARKING OF TRAILERS, ETC. ELSEWHERE.**
10. **No dogs in or around the barn.**

Animal Livestock Regulations

In addition to rules and regulations that may be listed in the front of this book under General Rules, the following rules and regulations will apply to livestock and other animal entries.

All exhibitors are limited to exhibiting not more than two animals in any one dairy, beef, sheep, swine, or dairy goat class.

Each livestock exhibitor will be required to show their **own** animal in the showmanship contest unless instructed otherwise by the Judge or Superintendent. Prior entry for all livestock and dairy animals shall be required in the show. Exhibit space will be according to division entries. Stall space will be assigned by show committee.

All exhibitors of livestock must furnish his/her own feed, feed pans and watering equipment. Sawdust will be provided for bedding **if available**. All livestock must be shown by the owner, or with the assistance of one other Junior except when owner is ill or in the Armed Forces, in which case the animal may be shown by another Junior. Adults will not be permitted in the show ring assisting with the showing of any animals.

Grade and Purebred animals will be shown in the same classes.

Animal Health Requirements for Exhibition – 2021

Health Certificates

A health certificate must accompany all goats and sheep to be exhibited and be available on request by animal health officials. Animals with active lesions of “ringworm” with resulting loss of hair, or “warts” easily visible without close examination will not be permitted to exhibit and shall be subject to isolation or expulsion depending upon the nature and seriousness of the disease. All health certificates will be turned in and held for review by state veterinarian.

!!!Health Papers will be checked by Superintendents!!!
