

Chapter 26--ParksSubchapter A--Park Board

26.010. The board shall be comprised of a president and five (5) other members. The board shall select a president, vice president and secretary from the members of the board. The president shall vote only to break a tie. Top two (2) members to retire each year. Remaining members to move up. No members shall serve more than three (3) years in succession.

Subchapter B--Park Regulations

26.100. Rules and Regulations. The following rules and regulations are hereby adopted for the use of Stebbin's Park in the City of Sarcoxie:

1. The Park shall be closed at 10:30 p.m. and opened at 6:00 a.m. and no person shall use, occupy, enter into or cross said Park between the hours of 10:30 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. unless otherwise specifically permitted by action of the Park Board.
2. No person entering upon or using said Park shall damage or destroy any property located therein or thereon, nor shall such person make or cause to be made loud or unusual noises or operate any radio or mechanical musical device in such a manner as to disturb the peace of persons within or without said Park.
3. No person shall leave or deposit any trash, cans or debris upon any part of said park or the improvements therein, except in designated trash cans.
4. No motor vehicle shall be operated in or upon any portion of said Park, except designated driveways and parking areas.
5. No person shall operate a motor vehicle within said park at a speed in excess of fifteen (15) miles per hour.

26.110. Additional rules. The Park Board of the City of Sarcoxie is hereby authorized to enact such further rules and regulations governing the conduct of said Park as shall be reasonable and necessary, which rules shall become fully effective when published or posted.

26.120. Violations. The violation of any of the foregoing rules and regulations, or any rules and regulations hereafter duly adopted by the Park Board, shall constitute a misdemeanor and subject the violator to prosecution in the Police Court of the City of Sarcoxie in the manner provided for such violators.
